- 1. During the year we were able to recommence our meetings and after a year of not collecting members subscriptions we were able to generate income from that source again. We also welcomed 61 visitors to our meetings which generated £183.
- 2. Revenue from book sales also increased substantially. Many thanks to those involved for generating this income.
- Finally, on the Income side we received a very welcome donation of £500 from the developers of the Compstall Co-operative Building, near Compstall Mill. Special thanks should go to our Chair Hilary Atkinson who did so much to bring about this donation.
- 4. The expenditure items I believe are self explanatory. I am of course more than happy to answer any questions members may have at the meeting to which these accounts are presented or in private afterwards.
- 5. For the sake of clarification, the subscriptions the society pays are to the following

 - b) The Cheshire Local History Association

 - d) The British Newspaper Archive
- 6. Finally, whilst we see a welcome return to a surplus(profit) this year this would not have been possible without the generous £500 donation we received. Hopefully in 2022/23 we will see a return to a surplus (profit) arising from the normal day to day activities of the society. The committee will I am sure monitor carefully.
